

Gandhi Jayanti 2020 Celebration

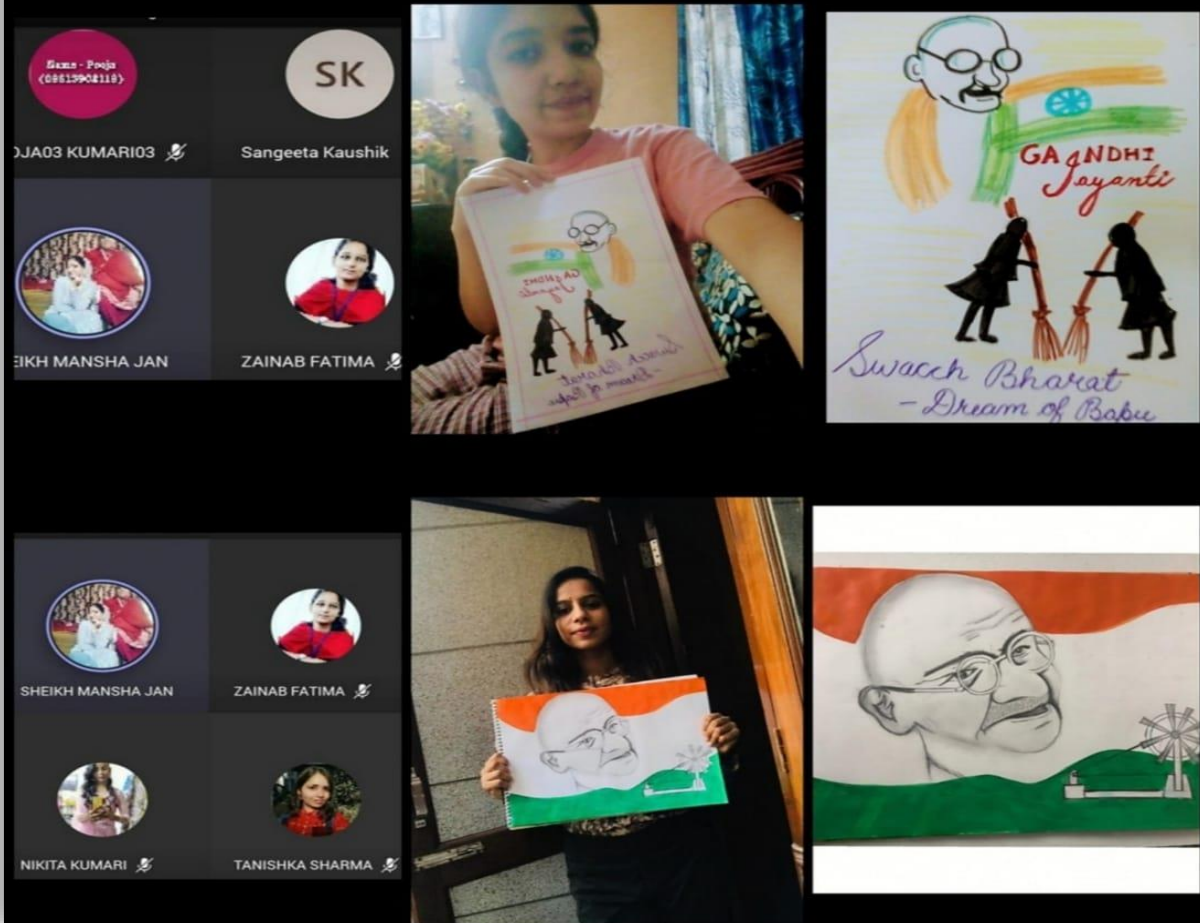
