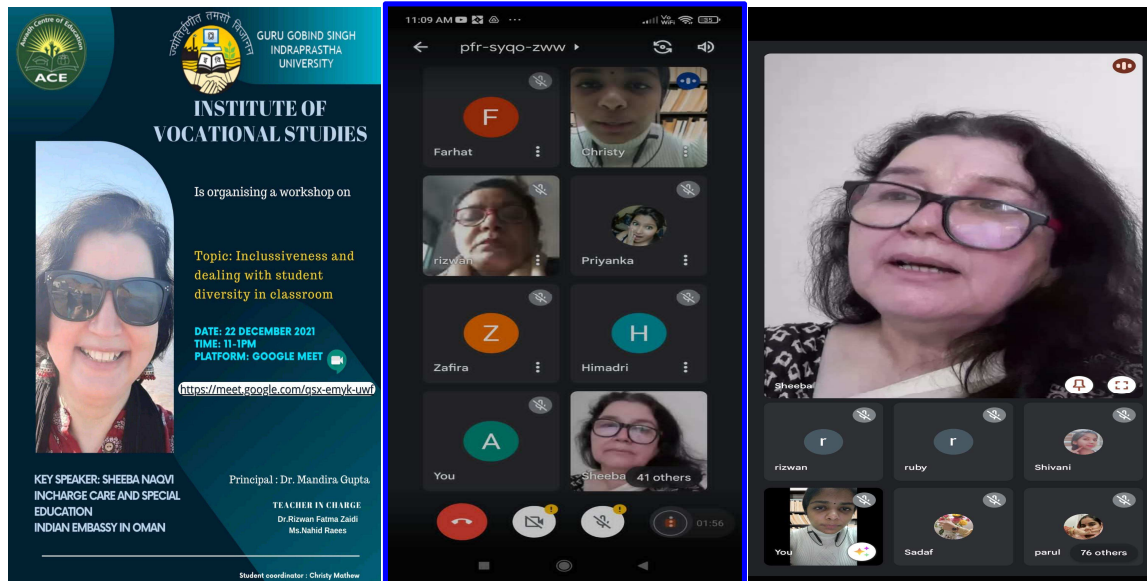


WORKSHOP ON INCLUSIVENESS AND DEALING WITH STUDENT DIVERSITY IN CLASSROOM (22nd December 2021)
