A National Conference on the theme “Reinventing Values in Currently Challenging Scenario: Developing an Insight into Ethical Intelligence in the light of NEP 2020” under IQAC was organized by Institute of Vocational Studies (GGSIPU), New Delhi on 25th April, 2023. Main objective of the conference was Reinventing Values in Currently Challenging Scenario in the light of National Education Policy 2020.

Inaugural ceremony of the event began with the Lamp lighting, after that welcome address was given by Dr. Mandira Gupta, Principal, IVS. Inaugural address was given by Prof. (Dr.) Ilias Husain, Director, IVS and discussed about the need of reinventing the values.

Esteemed Guest Speaker, Dr. Anjali Shokeen, from University School of Education (GGSIPU), New Delhi focused on the theme of the conference.
