REPORT OF EXTENSION LECTURE

New Trends in Evaluation

29th November 2023

Institute of Vocational Studies organized an extension lecture on 29th November, 2023 under the guidance of Director sir, Prof. Ilyas Husain, and Principal ma'am, Dr. Mandira Gupta. The coordinator of the lecture was Ms. Priyanka Gupta.

The Resource Person for the Extension Lecture was Mr. Mohd. Mamur Ali who is an Assistant Professor at IASE, JMI. He is also contributing as Academic Counsellor in IGNOU, MANUU and Centre for Distance and Open Education (CDOE).

The event began with a felicitation offered to Dr. Mohmmad Mamur Ali sir by our respected Principal ma'am, Dr. Mandira Gupta. The faculty members of IVS also attended the lecture.

The session began with the basic introduction of assessment and evaluation by the resource person. Sir reflected upon certain important aspects of assessment and evaluation that could be new to one's mind, which helped the students develop a common understanding of evaluation and its purpose.

The lecture introduced students to the new evaluation trends in light of the evolving nature of education and the need for innovative approaches to assess the performance of students. In the light of NEP 2020, the lecture emphasized the critical remarks of present assessment and evaluation practices. The most recent grading and marking system formats were also covered in this session. The lecture reflected on some serious challenges or concerns pertaining to the evaluation/assessment process of the students like textbook-based evaluation, etc.

The salient features of the School Based Assessment system and its process were discussed in detail by the resource person. Dr. Mamur Ali sir also spoke at length about major concerns in students' assessment. Other factors like 360-degree evaluation, Rubrics, and online resources that can be used to create holistic assessment tools were also covered. Throughout the presentation, new examination formats including on-demand and online examinations were also explored.

The session ended with a question hour where students posed their queries which were brilliantly answered by the resource person in an elaborative and informative manner.
