Our Philosophy



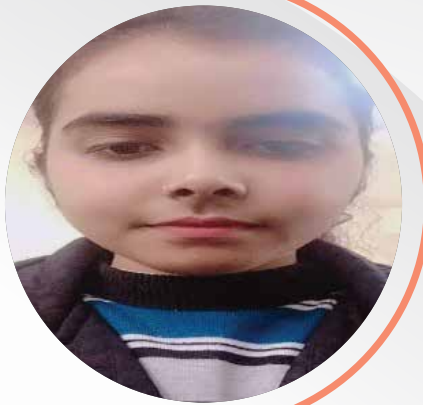
Maryada plays a significant role in life. Propriety is not a thing to preach but to practice.
